Project Description



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Layer 1:

Senoprint® UV Silver Mirror Finish 92F 7900

Applied as the first layer of the print construction, this silver coating creates a reflective foundation that enhances the interaction of colour and light. The result is a metallic appearance that adds brilliance and visual depth to the design.



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Layer 2:

UV Offset Ink

Printed over the silver base, the ink layer provides the colour and image detail of the design. The reflective silver layer beneath enhances the colours with a distinctive metallic appearance.



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Layer 3:

Senolith® UV Offset Matt Varnish 220 1010 UV

Applied as a full-surface coating, this matt UV varnish creates a smooth and elegant finish that reduces light reflection and provides a subtle backdrop for the subsequent coating effects.

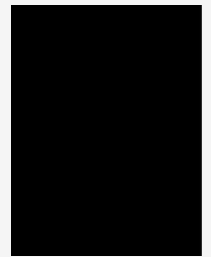


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Layer 4:

Senolith® UV High Gloss Varnish Hybrid 82F 7500

Used selectively with the matt coating, this gloss varnish creates a striking contrast, adding depth and enhancing the premium look of the print.



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Layer 5: (backside card)

Sensora® WB FP Matt Coating 20F 5000

This matt coating on the backside creates a smooth, soft-touch feel that contributes to a refined and premium experience.
